

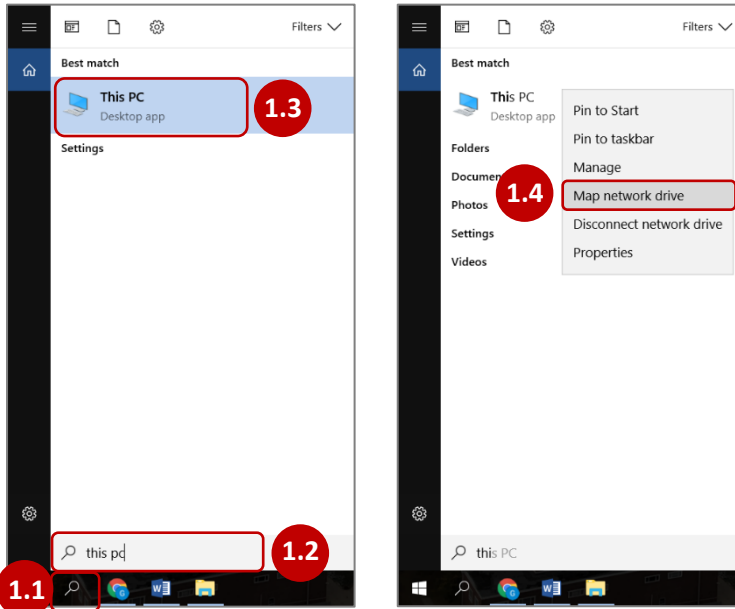


How to Access to Network Drives in Window (Department Network Drive and Personal H Drive)

If you are **off campus**, your computer needs to be connected to the Illinois State University network through the VPN.

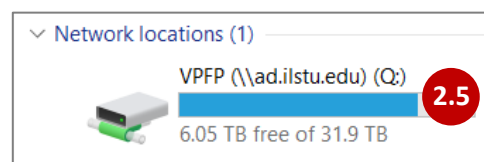
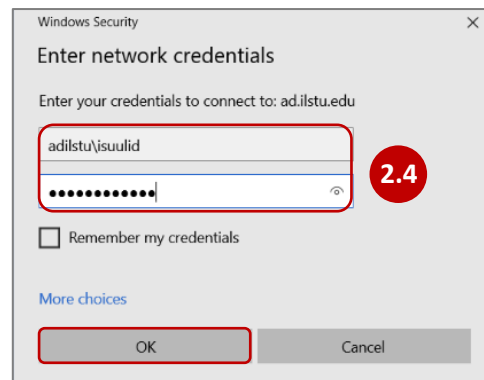
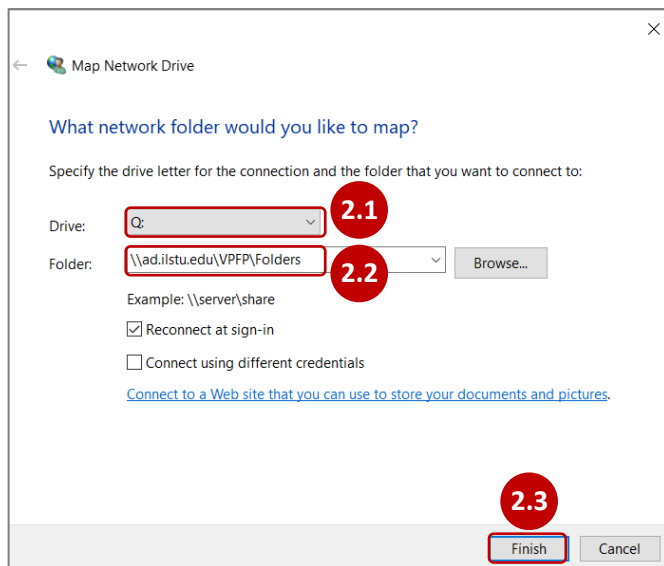
*Internet connection is required to connect to the VPN.

1. Find Map Network Drive window.
 - 1.1. Click the magnify glass icon at the bottom left of your computer or laptop screen.
 - 1.2. Type in *this pc* in the window search bar.
 - 1.3. Right click on *This PC*.
 - 1.4. Select *Map Network Drive*.



2. Enter the appropriate network path that you want to have access to.
Example 1: You want to access to the **Facilities Management network drive** that you currently have access to.

- 2.1. Select *Q:*.
- 2.2. Type `\\ad.ilstu.edu\VPFP\Folders`.
- 2.3. Click *Finish*.
- 2.4. Type your *Illinois State ULID* after `adilstu\` and password. Then, click *OK*.
- 2.5. You should now be able to access to the network drive.





Example 2: You want to access to your **personal H drive** that you usually access from University computer or laptop.

2.1a Select **H:**.

2.1b Type [\\ad.ilstu.edu\VPFP\Users\isuulid](#).

2.1c Click **Finish**.

2.1d Type your *Illinois State ULID* after *adilstu* and password. Then, click **OK**.

2.1e You should now be able to access to your personal H drive.
